The Agnus Dei

The Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) is the emblem of the Moravian Church. The Moravian Church is one of the oldest Protestant denominations in the world, with its heritage dating back to the Bohemian Reformation in the fifteenth century, when exiles from Moravia (today, Czech Republic) fled to Germany to escape religious persecution. The Church's emblem is the Lamb of God (*Agnus Dei*) with the flag of victory, surrounded by the Latin inscription: *Vicit agnus noster, eum sequamur* (English: "Our Lamb has conquered, let us follow Him").
